Started with Monsanto at the Cupertino location in the spring of 1973 doing general accounting work. Transferred in January 1976 to Monsanto, St. Louis into the International Financial Audit Department. Traveled to US and international Monsanto locations doing financial and operational audits. Left Monsanto in summer of 1978 and moved back to southern California with a career change into real estate brokerage and construction.

Became Sales Director for the Skyline, a midrise condo project in downtown L.A., in the summer of 1983. At the conclusion of the Skyline in early 1986, accepted a position with one of the Skyline lenders, First Nationwide Bank, as National Residential REO Sales Manager selling foreclosed property in 26 states.

Left FNB in summer 1989 and relocated my family to Atlanta, Georgia and accepted a job with the Resolution Trust Corp/FDIC as Southeastern Regional Disposition Manager of Residential Properties under the Affordable Housing Program. Stayed there till the bitter end when the RTC Federal Charter had run its course in 1996 and all 7000 employees had to find new positions. Stayed connected to the government by working for HUD as project manager of a 400 unit "affordable housing" apartment rehab project.

As the HUD assignment was winding down, I was hired in June 1998 as a business consultant by an MBA classmate. When the business plan was completed he offered me a position to implement the plan until I found a more suitable position. I am still here with Atlanta Oral & Facial Surgery which has grown to be the largest oral surgery private practice in the U.S.
